THE PASSAGE:

The first covenant tabernacle and sacrifices had purpose but were inadequate

- Tabernacle <u>limited access</u> to God. Jesus <u>opened access to all</u> believers
- Sacrifices provided a <u>temporary remedy for sin</u>. Jesus completely removes it.

Propitiation = <u>satisfy the wrath of God</u> Expiation = <u>wipe away sin</u>

- Christ's sacrifice provides eternal redemption
- Christ's sacrifice provides <u>a clear conscience</u>
